White Salmon is located in a quiet community along the Columbia River Gorge about 60 miles east of Vancouver, WA. Its excellent climate, often described as “The Land Where The Sun Meets The Rain,” is due to its location in a transition zone between the marine-influenced climate west of the Cascades and the dry continental climate of the inter-mountain region.

Offering a stunning view of Mount Hood, White Salmon is convenient to many outdoor activities from fishing, hiking, skiing and also water sports such as windsurfing and boating. This is a growing area due to opportunities in the high tech industry.



White Salmon UMC is a full-time appointment with an average worship attendance of 47 and a staff that includes a part-time secretary, part-time children’s SS teacher/daycare, janitorial service, and volunteer music staff. The historic building is located near city center, is used by many community groups and has been well maintained and updated. A 3 bedroom, 2¾ bath ranch style parsonage with a yard and garage is provided.

This active ministry holds two adult Sunday School classes, a monthly potluck program, and excellent music and audio-visual capabilities. Outreach includes Backpack for Kids, Project Hope (provides personal care needs), and projects through the local ministerial association. This is an energetic, servant-hearted congregation that is ready to be in ministry to the White Salmon community and looking for a pastor to lead them into their mission field.
