Edmonds UMC is a regional church of 751 members serving the communities of Edmonds, Lynwood, Mountlake Terrace, Brier, Shoreline, Mukilteo, and Lake Forest Park. The city of Edmonds is located in Snohomish County and has about 41,000 residents. Much of the city borders beautiful Puget Sound. The congregation has two appointed pastors with a total of thirty full and part-time staff. The average Sunday morning worship attendance is 318. The church has an excellent music program consisting of multiple choirs covering children, youth, and adult ages. There are additional strong Christ-centered programs for both youth and children.



Among the many community outreach ministries Edmonds hosts a food bank that feeds an average of 350 families a week, and a toy shop that serves over 450 families during the Christmas season. Additionally, the church runs a weekly tutoring program that reaches over 80 students in the Edmonds school district. Edmonds UMC has a very strong emphasis on social justice, and is committed to working toward the elimination of poverty. There is also an active Stephen's Ministry.

In the words of the Edmonds SPRC:

"As we look toward the future it is our hope and desire that our next leader is able to help us grow in faith. To that end we feel we will be best served by a leader with strong preaching skills that challenge us in new ways to deepen our faith individually and collectively. While our community is on a positive path, it is not our desire to stop and rest. We feel called to continue to press forward.
