The Davenport Edwall Parish describes themselves as one church in two locations, and they are located in both Davenport and Edwall, Washington just west of Spokane.

Davenport is the larger of the two towns, and is the center point for the parish (and is where the parsonage is located), but they are active in ministry in the surrounding region, including in downtown Spokane.

Sunday worship right now has 9 AM worship in Edwall (with Bible Study at 8 AM), and 11 AM in Davenport, and it is about a 20-25 minutes travel time between each location. This area of Lincoln County has deep values around their community, they are located in a fairly conservative community (Edwall even more so than Davenport), and they are requesting someone who can help lead their leadership teams to be inspired to find their own ministry, with a lot of attention given to preaching and worship leadership.

They do not have significant financial challenges but they do express that they have difficulty in reaching younger generations of folks. They are in a period of discernment for their calling within the region, and they are looking for a pastor that matches their community, who will come in with new ideas, energy, and can lead the kind of transformation they are praying for in their community.
